Wood Green Animal Shelter

Peter Dann were commissioned to assist Dan Curtis of TCC to design a new reception building, welfare facilities and two kennel blocks in the expansion of the Wood Green Animal facility at Godmanchester.

The buildings were configured to allow public viewing of the animals when awake and active but the sleeping and service side was only available to Wood Green staff to avoid difficult situations.

The structures were of block and timber frame construction. The reception and welfare buildings had trench fill foundations but a raft foundation was used for the kennel blocks.

The drainage had to be carefully planned as each kennel had bespoke stainless steel drainage systems. Careful consideration had to be given to potential contaminated areas being drained to the foul sewers to comply with EA requirements.
