Secure Residential Accommodation, Beverley

This building was part of a development of a large area in the centre of Beverley for which Peter Dann was the Civil and Structural Consulting Engineers. Although our client was a property developer this building was designed to meet the requirements of the Local Health Authority to provide secure accommodation for residents with special requirements.

The building was a two-storey block and contained 30 secure rooms, shared bathroom facilities, communal areas, kitchens, dining rooms and offices.

The structure consisted of pre-cast concrete floors supported on load bearing masonry. There was a separate steel framed structure to support plant and tanks within the roof.

Other work on this site included the conversions of an old manor house into apartments, including a 3 storey extension, a new nursery school for the Local Authority and the conversion of an old coach house into a terrace of self contained dwelling units.
