

Restoration / Residential

Peter Dann were appointed as structural engineering consultants for the original design of this scheme in the 1970's. The original scheme for the sheltered housing consisted of two storeys of traditional construction to provide 28 residential units, with community services and recreational areas. In addition individual accommodation was provided for the wardens.

25 years later the local authority reviewed its stock of sheltered housing schemes and chose to refurbish and extend this complex. The individual units were refurbished and upgraded to comply with improved national standards with three additional units added to provide "bungalow" accommodation.

The communal areas were modified and upgraded to provide modern facilities, including a new entrance feature and reception lounge.
